

NYQP Database Administrator's Guide

The NYQP Database is an extensive web based multi-year method of storing and scoring participants logs.

1.) Upload Logs

Although there is a separate button to upload logs from each year, the log will get posted to the year seen in the QSOs of the log.

2.) Select Official Categories

Often the upload process does not identify the participant's categories precisely. An administrator may adjust the "Official Categories" as deemed necessary.

While editing you can also mark this entrant for categories that are not evident from the Cabrillo log. For example: Rookie, Youth, etc.

3.) Define Unique Callsigns

For the most part, unique callsigns are given credit for the QSO. However, an administrator may wish to deny credit by marking certain uniques as busted.

4.) Select Award Winners

Award winners are selected on each winners Log Stat page.

5.) Edit Awards Page

Once the award winners are selected, their callsign and total points are listed on the Awards page. An administrator may wish to expand on the winners and/or donors description.
